

### **Video Cameras on School Buses**

The Lynden School District authorizes the use of video cameras on district operated school buses for the recording of both images and sound. The purposes for recording the transportation environment include reducing discipline problems, answering questions, and providing documentation to school officials, bus drivers, and parents/guardians/custodians related to inappropriate behavior and/or other concerns that could adversely impact the safety and welfare of students and/or bus drivers. Disciplinary action will be in accordance with district policies and procedures 3200 and 3241, and the Student Handbook.

The Superintendent will prepare procedures for use of the video equipment on buses, the authorized review process for videotapes, and the proper disposal of tapes.
